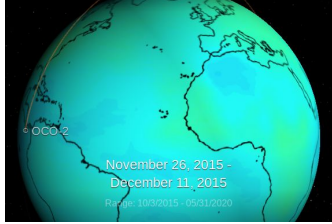
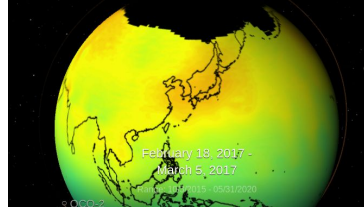


Carbon Dioxide Levels

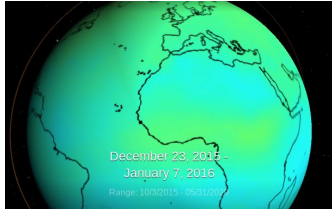

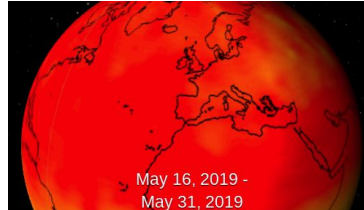
In November of 2015, the world's carbon levels were average, at about 400 ppm.



In February of 2017, the world's carbon levels raised to 406 ppm.

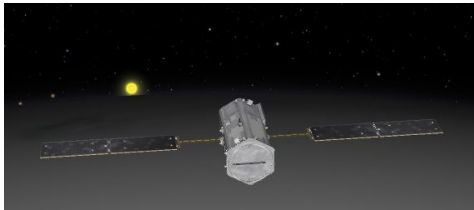


In December of 2016, the world's carbon levels slightly increased to about 404 ppm.
